Condition: excellent.

15. Cohn, Robert. **Clinical encephalography**. First edition. New York, London, Toronto:
McGraw-Hill Book Company, Inc., 1949.
Condition: This slightly oversize text is in very good condition.

21. Duchenne, Guillaume Benjamin: Emanuel B. Kaplan, translator and editor. **Physiology of Motion, demonstrated by means of electrical stimulation and clinical observation and applied to the study of paralysis and deformities**. Philadelphia and London: W.B. Saunders, 1959.

Condition: excellent. The original publication of this most important publication of Duchenne was 1867. Duchenne has been credited with the discovery of locomotor ataxia, progressive muscular paralysis and glossopharyngeal paralysis.

25. Flugge, Dr. C. **Die Mikroorganismen**. Leipzig: F. C. W. Vogel, 1886.

Condition: fair. Spine worn, lacking leather covering. Leather corners and marbled boards and endpapers. Boards separated from spine.
