Condition: excellent, complete with dust jacket.

Condition: good. Original leather covers and spine are intact although worn. The leather title plate on the spine is loose. The text block exhibits some slight foxing and staining, but is otherwise clean and complete. There are two colored plates at the start of Chapter 1.
