



Search Tags & Field Qualifiers

Search Fields follow search terms in square brackets.
 For example, to search diabetes as a MeSH term:
 Type `diabetes mellitus[MH]` in the search box in PubMed.

Author Affiliation	[AD]	First listed author's institutional affiliation
Author	[AU]	Author name
Corporate Name as Author	[CN]	Corporate names as authors
EC/RN Number	[RN]	CAS Registry Number or Enzyme Commission Number
Entrez Date	[EDAT]	Date citation was added to database
Journal Title	[TA]	Title of journal
Language	[LA]	Language of the article (not the abstract)
MeSH Major Topic	[MAJR]	Main topic of an article
MeSH Subheading	[SH]	MeSH Subheading
MeSH Term	[MH]	MeSH Term
Personal Name as Subject	[PS]	Person as the subject of an article, not as an author
Publication Type	[PT]	Format of an article (letter, clinical trial, etc) rather than content
Subset	[SB]	Subject and citation subsets
Substance Name	[NM]	Chemical and substance names discussed in an article
Text Word	[TW]	Textual fields of PubMed records
Title	[TI]	Article title

Title or Abstract	[TIAB]	Words in an article title or an abstract

Searching Journal/Citation Subsets:

Enter the following in the search box: `jsubsetLetterofSubset AND search term`
 Ex: `jsubsetk AND diabetes`

Search Tip:

Always type the Boolean Operators AND, OR & NOT in capital letters

Journal/Citation Subsets:

d	dentistry journals
e	citations from the bioethics journals
h	health administration journals
k	consumer health journals
n	nursing journals
q	history of medicine journals
s	citations from space life sciences journals
t	health technology assessment journals, non-Index Medicus
x	AIDS/HIV journals (selected citations from other journals 1980-2000)

Full text in PubMed:

Free full text[*sb*] – links to free full-text article
 Full text[*sb*] – links to full-text article (not free)
`!provLinkOutCode[filter]` – all full text from library's LinkOut account
